## **St. Andrew's Society Annual Scholarship**

### **Criteria for Application:**

- Scholarships will be in the nature of financial assistance to members who want to improve their skills and/or knowledge in their particular area of interest in Scottish culture, i.e., dancing, music, certification, genealogy, history or language.
- **Awards may only be used for skill and/or knowledge improvement. *They may not be used for competition fees.***
- The Scholarship Committee will determine the amount of the awards to be given.
- The awards will be gifts and no repayment will be expected.
- The Scholarship Committee must receive applications by **March 15, 2008**
- Award winners will be announced at the St. Andrew's Society Annual Meeting.
- The recipient must be a Society member in good standing, or in the case of an applicant under age 18, at least one parent must be a member.
- Preference will be given to applications where other members of the St. Andrew's Society will also benefit from the skills or knowledge gained by the recipient, i.e., award receiving a teaching certificate whereby they will teach others.
- Awardees will be required to submit an article to the Society newsletter, *The Thistle Epistle*, reporting their experiences and what they learned at the school, workshop, or seminar that they attended.
- Awardees will be required to give a presentation at the first annual meeting of the Society following the completion of the school, workshop or seminar.
- Scholarship funds are only payable directly to the school for tuition fees. They may not be used to defray personal expenses.
